What is Filmclub?

Our FILMCLUB aims to make a wide range of films available to children, which challenge, unite, educate, amaze and inspire. Your child will have the opportunity to explore the wonderful world of film and use the FILMCLUB website www.intofilm.org to search for the films they want to watch, submit reviews and enter exciting competitions!

The films shown in our film club will be a U or a PG rating. The film classifications are explained below. **Please note we will always advertise the weekly film to be screened so that parents can make an informed decision on a weekly basis.**

Film Classifications

U – Suitable for audiences aged four years and over. U films should be set within a positive moral framework and should offer reassuring counterbalances to any violence, threat or horror.

PG – Parental Guidance – General viewing, but some scenes may be unsuitable for young children.

Refreshments

Film club will run on a Friday evening after school. We will be offering refreshments. The finish time will obviously vary according to the length of film and this will be advertised on a weekly basis. **You MUST book a place if your child will be attending film club by lunchtime on the Thursday so that we can cater accordingly. We will be serving Hot Dogs, popcorn and soft drinks for £3.00 per child payable in cash.**
