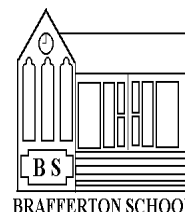

Arrangements for returning to school from March 8th

Dear Parents,

Following the Government announcement last week, we are really looking forward to welcoming the whole school back on Monday 8th March. We will continue to follow the North Yorkshire Health and Safety Guidance so that everyone can continue to stay safe upon their return to school. Our arrangements in school are as follows:

Drop off/collection:

- Doors will open for all main school pupils from 8:50am with registration being done at 9am. School will finish at 3.30pm.
- Helperbees to use the Helperbees entrance and arrive for 9am or shortly after to avoid gatherings and pick can be from 3.10pm.
- Class 1 children to use their classroom door.
- **Class 2 children to use their outside area door (along the car park side of school)**
- Class 3 children to use the side door near the Headteacher's Office
- One parent only collection
- Schools in North Yorkshire have advised all parents to continue wearing face coverings on the school premises) and adhere to 2m social distancing rule (thank you for your co-operation in this)

All children to be in smart school uniform including school PE kit on PE days.

All children will need their school book bags and water bottles. Mrs Gledhill will provide delicious school lunches (**please inform the school office whether your child will have school lunch, alternatives and packed lunch by THURSDAY this week**).

PE will be on Wednesdays and Thursdays and **ALL** children are to come to school in PE kit on these days. A polite request that everyone has a spare bag of clothes which can stay in school 'just in case'.

Forest Schools will begin for Class 1 on Thursday mornings so Forest Kit will be required on Thursdays (indoor shoes and wellies that day please).

A polite request that all school equipment and home learning books are returned on Monday 8th March or before if possible. Please could this come back in a named plastic wallet/envelope so we can see who has returned the equipment. We have lots of school equipment, including reading books, out there!



School laptops, which have been out for loan, need to be returned by Monday 8th March to the school office.

Our Breakfast and After School will re-open from 8th March. Please book your child's place via **base@st-peters-brafferton.n-yorks.sch.uk**.

Sporting Influence will be offering an outdoor PE after school club on Wednesdays 3.30-4.30pm (£3 per child per week). Please sign up for the club through **admin@st-peters-brafferton.n-yorks.sch.uk**.

Exciting news...our Easter Holiday Club will be open from Monday 29th March-Thursday 1st April. £25 full day (8.30-5.30pm) and £12.50 half day (8.30am-1pm). Children **must** be provided a packed lunch as there will be no food on site. Deadlines for Easter Holiday Club requests are the Friday before the Holiday Club begins. Please book your child's place via **base@st-peters-brafferton.n-yorks.sch.uk**.

Additional Covid measures we have in place are:

- Classes will remain within their own class where possible including at playtime where they will play in class zones
- Staff will wear face coverings in communal areas such as corridors and drop off/collection times
- All staff and children will follow a regular hand washing routine throughout the school day
- All children will continue to eat their lunches in their classrooms
- Classrooms will be ventilated throughout the day (please ensure your child wears layers under their uniform if needed)
- Staff have access to Covid tests twice a week
- Pupils, staff and other adults **must not come into the school** if:
 - they have one or more coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms
 - a member of their household (including someone in their support bubble or childcare bubble if they have one) has coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms
 - they have had a positive test
- If a child is ill such as a high fever, cough or has a loss of taste or smell, parents will be contacted immediately and the child will wait in the school entrance with Mrs Lee until collected.
