Shape

Y2: Properties of 2D & 3D shapes including the sides, vertices, edges, lines of symmetry & patterns

Length, Height, Perimeter

Y2: measure in cm, m, compare lengths & heights, order lengths & heights

Y3: measure in cm, mm, m. Work out equivalent lengths, add, subtract & compare lengths. Measure & calculate perimeter.

Multiplication & Division

Y2: recognise & make equal groups, arrays, grouping & sharing. 2, 5, 10 times tables & dividing by 2, 5, 10.

Y3: multiply & divide by 2, 5, 10, 3, 4, 8. Multiply & divide 2 digit numbers by a 1 digit. Scaling.
