As you're probably aware, the cost of goods is increasing, and sadly, as a school we have our costs increasing too. North Yorkshire County Caterers charge us a fixed meal price and this has gone up in recent months. As of 1st September, the cost of a school meal will be £2.60 per child in main school and Helperbees £2.40. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to free school meals automatically as part of a government initiative, but costs apply to Helperbees and Year 3-6. Depending on your circumstances, you maybe entitled to Free School Meals where your child can have a free school dinner and extra funding to increase their learning opportunities.
