Governance Arrangements:

The Governing Body of the school was re-constituted in July 2018 and it now made up of: 12 Governors and 2 Associate Governors. 7 Foundation Governors, 2 Staff Governors, 2 Parent Governors and 1 Local Authority Governor and 2 Associate Governors (14)

It is essential that all Governors should have Knowledge and skills in safeguarding, finance, leadership, monitoring, health and safety, planning and strategic goal setting, in order to contribute to effective governance and the success of the school.

The Governing body has a programme of meetings throughout the school year, and has 1 FGB structure, that focuses on all areas of governance. These meetings are held 7 times a year and each meeting, there is an agreed focus.
